CDL Driver Job Description

Qualifications:

- Must have current Class A CDL and a good motor vehicle report.
- Safety-first mindset.
- Six months of over-the-road experience or graduate of approved truck driver training school.
- High school diploma or GED preferred.
- Safety: This position assumes responsibility for the workplace safety of self and co-workers, and for the safety conditions of the work locations, exercise and promotes safe behaviors and show unyielding support of programs, rules and policies regarding safety.
- Must be able to adhere to Driver DOT and County Drug & Alcohol Policies.

Responsibilities:

- Environment: Work in all weather conditions.
- Safely and efficiently operate truck equipment to transport road materials.
- Comply with all legal and regulatory requirements set by the Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), and any other governing body.
- Read and understand load paperwork and product and packaging descriptions.
- Flexibility and ability to assist in other road work duties including mowing and tree trimming.
- Ability to lift up to 40 pounds, long sitting, walking, or standing during work hours.
- Work hours are Monday – Friday, however flexibility in weekends and holidays during weather events.
